



BLIND CODING

> Task:

Round 1: Participants are required to write the code with PC screen off.

Round 2: Participants will be given various challenges to solve.

> Participation:

- 1) Team Participation is Allowed.
- 2) A Team can consist of 2 Members at Max.
- 3) Only 1 Member of the Team can take part in 1st Round.

Event Rules:

There will be two Rounds.

Round 1

- 1. There can be individual participation only.
- 2. Participants have to write the code of the given problem with the correct syntax with computer screen off.
- 3. The participants won't be allowed to use pen and paper during this Round.
- 4. They would be writing the code on notepad.
- 5. After completing the code, participants will be given time of 25-30 secs to switch on the screen and check their code on the notepad to rectify the errors.
- 6. The student coordinator will copy that code to the compiler and check it for errors and he will also note the time taken to write the code.
- 7. Coordinators decision are final and should not be questioned.
- 8. Malpractices will lead to immediate disqualification.
- 9. The leaderboard is based purely on the time completed to maintain equality.
- 10. The participants with minimum errors in the code will move to Round 2.

(Note: Round 1 Will take Place in Computer Lab)





Round 2

- 1. Teams will be given challenges to solve. The challenges will be based on Web, Forensics, logical and cryptic.
- 2. The Team which solves most number of challenges will be adjudged as winner.
- 3. Coordinators decision are final and should not be questioned.
- 4. Malpractices will lead to immediate disqualification.
- 5. The leaderboard is based purely on the time completed to maintain equality.
- 6. Denial of Service or any kind of attack on the challenge server is Prohibited.
- 7. Teams can take help from the Internet as long as they don't violate any rules.

(Note: Teams should Bring their own Laptops with pre-installed tools for this round)

▶ Judging Criteria: Student coordinators will be there and they would be counting errors and checking the time of the respective participant. Limited teams will be sent to the 2nd Round.

The Team which solves the most number of challenges in the Second Round will be adjudged as the Overall Winner of the Blind Coding Competition.

In Case of tie in any Round, the total time taken to solve the challenges will be taken into Consideration.
