Task

This interactive quiz session is designed to highlight some of the different areas of biotechnology and biosciences. Each team will participate in three rounds consisting of theoretical and analytical questions.

Arena

A room will required with projector, laptop, extension boards, buzzers and sound system facilities. Desk and chairs will be required for proper sitting arrangement of judges, team members and viewers.

Event Rules

- 1. Only team entries are eligible.*
- 2. A team shall consist of max two persons*
- 3. The decision of the quiz-master will be final and will not be subjected to any change.*
- 4. The participants shall not be allowed to use mobile or other electronic instruments.*
- 5. The questions shall be in the form of multiple choice, True / False statement, Specific-answer question etc.*
- 6. Audience shall not give any hints or clues to the competitors.*
- 7. Replacement of any participant of a team is not allowed after registration*
- 8. Teams selected for the final rounds will be allowed to give themselves an appropriate name related to the competition by which they may want to be known*

ELIMINATION ROUND – (In case more than 15 teams register)

- Each team would be given a set of question paper containing 25 multiple choice objective type questions*
- Time limit - 15 minutes*
- Only 6 Teams would be selected for STAGE ROUNDS*
- In case of tie between 2 or more teams, further 5 questions would be asked for final selection*
- The selected teams shall have to appear for the final round*

FINAL QUIZ- STAGE ROUNDS

Round 1: Rapid-fire Round

- Each team will be asked questions, one after another in 1 minute time.*
- 10 marks for the correct answer.*
- No negative marking for wrong answers.*



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- If a team cannot answer the question, they can say '**PASS**' for the next question.
- The question will **not** be forwarded to the next team.
- **10 teams** will be selected for next round.

Round 2: Visual round

Teams will be shown clips and will have to answer. rounds 2 : **20 questions**

- 10 marks for the correct answer and negative 5 marks for the wrong answer
- Each Team would be asked 2 audio-visual questions. (1 slide in each round)
- Answering time is only 30 seconds.
- **5 teams** will be selected for final round.

No passing to the next team. Audience can answer

Round 3 – Buzzer Round- A question will be fired & the team who presses the buzzer first get to answer first – **6 Questions**

- 10 marks for the correct answer and negative 5 marks for the wrong or if team doesn't after they press Buzzers. – No forwarding
- Answering time is only 30 seconds

**** SURPRISE ROUND IN CASE OF TIE IN THE FINAL ROUND**

Judging Criteria

The criteria for judging the competition will be based on the score and completeness of the quiz portion and the appropriateness of the solution to the design problem; including but not limited to: quality, originality, thoroughness.
